最近の「ホワイトカラー」関連文献

「ホワイト・カラー」問題が一般的に取り上げられるようになったのは、今世紀初頭のことであつた。しかしながら、これらは、最近になって改めてにわかに注目されはじめている。この原因としては、先進資本主義国における経済の「ソフト化」「サービス化」の進展によって「ホワイトカラー」といわれる階層の労働者数が急激に増大してきたこと、オフィス・オートメーションと呼ばれる事務部門のコンピュータ化が急速に進展したことの二点が上げられる。

こうした中で、ホワイトカラーに関する研究も、様々な国で、最近急速に行われるようになっており、それらの全体的な動向が注目されている。

こうした状況から、ここでは、世界各国における最近のホワイトカラー文献を紹介することにした。

ここに収録したリストは、筆者が、1990年4月から翌年の3月まで、アメリカ合衆国のオハイオ州立アクロン大学に Visiting Scholar として滞在中に整理したものである。

掲載された資料は、オハイオ州立アクロン大学、オハイオ州立ケント大学、ハーバード大学、ペンシルベニア大学、U. C. L. A.、及びカナダのトロント大学の各大学図書館のそれぞれの図書館データベースから収録したものを、主に、1970年以後の最近の文献を抽出し、必要な情報だけを加工し、重複を削除して、リストアップしたものである。文献情報は、著者、タイトル(イタリックで表示)、発行所、発行地、発行年、その他、が著者名のアルファベット順で並べられているが、複数の著者や、編者による文献は文献名によるアルファベット順に並べられている。また、副題の一部が途中から省略されている(……で表示)ものが一部含まれている。なお、リストアップされた文献には、アメリカ・イギリスなどの英語圏、ドイツ語圏、フランス語圏、ラテン語圏、中国語圏(ローマ字で表記)の文献のほか、日本語による文献(ローマ字で表記)が含まれている。あえて日本の文献をリストアップした理由は、アメリカにおいてどのような日本語文献が紹介されているのかをみるのが、何がしかの意義があると考えたからである。これらの日本語文献は、U. C. L. A. とハーバード大学の二つの図書館にのみ収録されていたものである。

本「資料」が当該分野の研究になんらかの形で役に立てば幸いである。
